This refers to your request for the Certificate of Legitimacy of the International Research and Innovation for Sustainable Education (I-RISE) Hybrid Conference 2025 to be held in your university. CHED-IAS as the designated National Information Center on Higher Education¹ hereby responds to your request.

Upon evaluation, the proposed International Research and Innovation for Sustainable Education (I-RISE) 2025 organized by Quezon City University (QCU) is a **LEGITIMATE** academic activity aligned with RA 7722. The conference objectives are relevant, the registration fees are reasonable, and no red flags were noted.

However, while the activity is valid and supportive of CHED's thrusts, **CHED CANNOT ISSUE AN ENDORSEMENT OR RECOMMENDATION** due to the existing Memorandum from the Office of the Chairperson dated 17 February 2020, which suspends the implementation of CMO No. 22, s. 2003 ("Revised Guidelines in Processing Requests for CHED Endorsement to Hold an Activity"). The conference may therefore proceed as planned but without formal CHED endorsement.
